

Tips on making a video



Thank you so much for participating in Vision 2019. We're delighted that you and/or your group are going to join the conversation on the future of the church. Here are some helpful hints to make your video a success.

- There's no need to hire a professional. Try to find someone in your parish or group who has a camera. Most any digital format is acceptable to us.
- Arrange your taping in a place with lots of light. Place the camera on a tripod or table for stability.
- Make sure the camera microphone is on so we can hear people speaking. Do a quick test before recording to make sure the camera is picking up the audio. Make sure to identify who and where you are.
- The files need to be uploaded to our server. The URL for upload is: <http://dropbox.yousendit.com/vision2019>
- We can take a wide variety of file formats, these include (but are not limited to):
 - Windows Media Video(.avi)
 - .3GP (cell phones)
 - .AVI (windows)
 - .MOV (mac)
 - .MP4 (ipod/psp)
 - .MPEG
 - .FLV (adobe flash)
 - .SWF (shockwave flash)
 - .MKV (h.264)
- If you have your video on a DVD, the file to send us is the .VOB file from the DVD
