ACCOMMODATION AT GENERAL SYNOD 2010

Dioceses are responsible for the cost of accommodation and meals for their delegates.

SAINT MARY'S UNIVERSITY RESIDENCES

Saint Mary's University in Halifax, site of General Synod 2010, offers convenient, affordable accommodation in its Loyola, Rice and Vanier residences, close to all General Synod activities.

Accommodation at Saint Mary's will be booked with registration, unless otherwise indicated. The cost of delegates' meals and accommodation will be billed to their diocese by General Synod.

A mixture of single, twin and apartment style rooms has been blocked for General Synod. Bedrooms are furnished as study rooms with a captain's-style single bed, desk with hutch, lamp, chair, closet space and telephone (free local calls). Linen is provided. Washrooms are shared. Internet connection is available in your room, but you will need to bring your own internet cable. Rooms will be assigned by General Synod. Those staying on campus will receive a Tower Fitness and Recreation Centre pass for the duration of their stay.
