Here are some ideas to get your creative juices flowing as you respond to the two-part Vision 2019 question, **"Where is your church now, and where do you want the Anglican Church of Canada to be in 2019?"**

Please add your voice to this creative project and encourage other Canadian Anglicans to do the same. We are all part of the church, and your stories are essential.

- Get a group of Sunday school kids together, then write or film their dreams.
- Pray about your own individual answer, then call and leave a message.
- Write a song about your answer, then call and *sing* your message.
- At your next parish potluck, walk around with a video camera and interview three or four people about the question.
- If you're a church leader, gather a diverse brainstorming group from your parish and write a joint letter.
- Find people new to your church and ask them what they think. Meet in front of a web cam and record your different perspectives.
- Write your answer in the form of a prayer, then email it in.
- Set up a storytelling corner after a church service, with stations where people can drop off written letters or tape their stories at a video camera.
- Provide letter-writing supplies for your next Bible study or prayer breakfast. Pray together about the question, then devote half an hour for everyone to write down their thoughts.
- Reach out to Anglicans who are housebound, elderly, sick, or others who might not be able to tell their stories without your help. Take the time to transcribe their thoughts, or film them.
